WP2 Piloting phase has already started!

Online Training Course and Face-to-Face workshops for Teachers

Any teacher working with newly arrived migrant students and those addressing the topic in their classrooms can now improve their professional skills and competences related to the social inclusion methods thanks to the online Training course available in different languages as well as a workshop that will prepare them for the integration of newly-arrived pupils.

The 4-module online course entitled “How to welcome migrant and refugee students in my classroom” was designed in the framework of the **PASSAGE WP2 Capacity building of professionals, role models and stakeholders**, is aimed at preparing teachers to deal with diversity, manage intercultural communication and promote social inclusion; promoting social collaboration and inclusion among pupils and the educational community; capacitating teachers with pedagogical approaches useful to welcome and integrate migrant and refugee pupils.

The online modules will be open and available on the online platform (Moodle) in the PASSAGE partners’ languages through the project website: <https://passageproject.eu/>

In addition to the training course, a 12-hour workshop has also been designed by two Portuguese pedagogical experts in order to enable teachers and pupils to act as role models in the integration process of new migrant and refugee pupils through the creation of a mentoring model. The PASSAGE mentoring model will aim at supporting the newly arrived student’s integration to the linguistic context and school environment, in the development of learning, clarification of doubts, preparation for evaluation moments and in other activities related to their integration in the education system.

The workshop will be carried out by experts in pedagogical practice (facilitators), aiming to transfer all the required knowledge for the implementation of next steps of the project. The Workshop Manual is openly available through our resources section: <https://passageproject.eu/resources/>
