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The project in a nutshell

PASSAGE aims to develop innovative and urgently needed solutions to ensure that newly-arrived children of third-country national background receive sufficient support in entering school life.

The programme

The pilot programme aims to provide the opportunity for students and teachers to act as “role models” in the integration process of newly arrived students from third countries (refugees, asylum seekers and migrants), through the creation of a mentoring model.

Mentoring is a strategy for accepting and integrating newly arrived children into the school system, providing them with guidance and support through peer-to-peer interaction, enhancing their personal, interpersonal and school development, while promoting friendship, sharing and cultural exchange.

Benefits

It promotes a close relationship between the student-mentor (role model) and newly arrived student (mentee), so that they can more easily express their difficulties and concerns

It benefits students and educators directly by providing an opportunity to develop skills and competencies such as communication, cooperation, empathy and responsibility

Teachers will no longer be alone in implementing reception and inclusion practices, encouraging the involvement of the whole school community

Planning


The programme is designed for students aged 6-15 years old and for the entire student population, regardless of their linguistic and cultural background or other educational aspects.
