

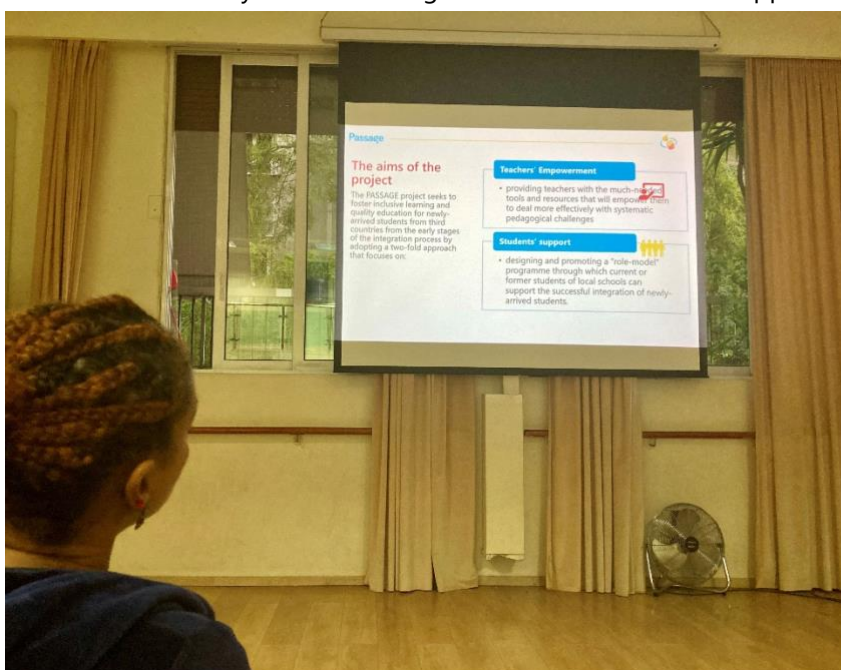

## PASSAGE Info day event in Greece

In October 2022 an info day event presenting the PASSAGE project to a wide audience took place in Greece. More than 40 participants, including professionals working in fields of migration and education, social scientists, youth workers, graduate students, and individuals with migrant and refugee background followed the event. The participants had the opportunity to learn more about the project, its objectives and the impact that PASSAGE aspires to generate in support of the ongoing efforts to ensure that newly-arrived children of third-country national background receive sufficient support in entering school life.

The PASSAGE platform and e-learning course on **“How to welcome migrant and refugee children in my classroom”**, the piloting programme of the project on **“Mentoring and Role Models”**, but also the findings **of the primary conducted in Greece** in order to explore the needs of newly-arrived students and their teachers were among the main aspects presented during the event.



The participants had the opportunity to discuss about the educational needs of newly-arrived children of third-country national background, exchange views and good practices, and share insights from their work and personal and professional experiences.

The info day was part of a series of events and face-to-face meetings performed in Greece by Symplexis in an effort to disseminate the project, its outputs and mentoring methodology to a wide audience and targeted stakeholders in the fields of migration and education.
