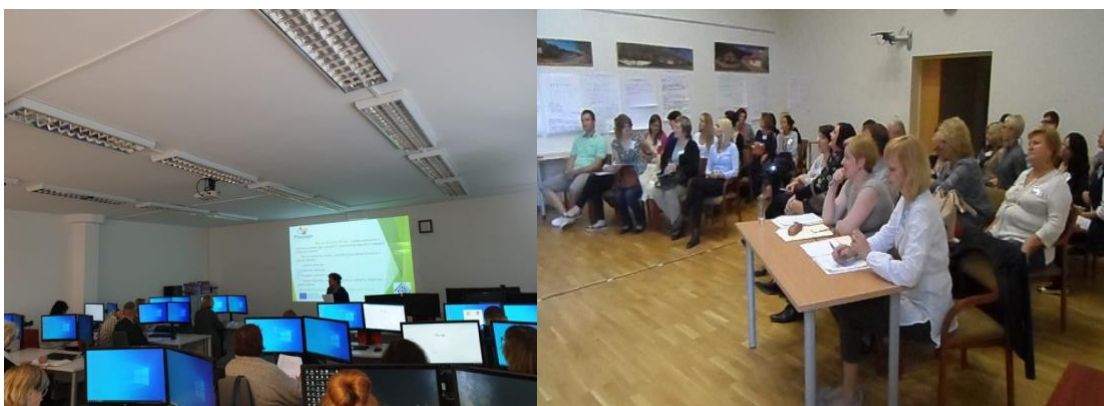
Project coordinators in Lithuania presented the main developed educational tools for teachers and school leaders:
